\$100 Q: What was Paul determined to know and preach among the church at Corinth?

A: Christ and Him crucified (2:2 For I determined to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ, and Him crucified.)

\$200 Q: Fill in the blank: For the word of the cross is _____ to those who are _____, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

A: (1:18 For the word of the cross is foolishness* to those who are perishing*, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.)

\$300 Q: What did Christ send Paul to do?

A: Preach the gospel (1:17 For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel)

\$400 Q: Fill in the blank: I _____, Apollos _____, but God was causing the _____.

A: (3:6 I planted*, Apollos watered*, but God was causing the growth*.)

\$500 Q: What will you receive for your labor for the Lord?

A: Your own reward (3:8 Now he who plants and he who waters are one; but each will receive his own reward according to his own labor.)

Category 2 People:

\$100 Q: Who aided Paul in writing 1 Corinthians?

A: Sosthenes (1:1 Paul, called as an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Sosthenes our brother)

\$200 Q: Fill in the blank: But a _____ man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are _____ to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised.

A: (2:14 But a natural* man does not accept the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness* to him; and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually appraised.)

\$300 Q: Paul desired to be regarded as what by men?

A: As a servant of Christ and steward of the mysteries of God (4:1 Let a man regard us in this manner, as servants of Christ and stewards of the mysteries of God.)

\$400 Q: Who informed Paul of the many quarrels in Corinth?

A: Chloe's people (1:11 For I have been informed concerning you, my brethren, by Chloe's people, that there are quarrels among you.)

\$500 Q: Who did Paul baptize?

A: Crispus and Gaius (1:14 I thank God that I baptized none of you except Crispus and Gaius,) Household of Stephanas (1:16 I did baptize also the household of Stephanas)

Category 3 Actions:

\$100 Q: Paul proclaimed to preach what?

A: Christ crucified (1:23 But we preach Christ crucified, to Jews a stumbling block and to Gentiles foolishness)

\$200 Q: Whom may we boast in?

A: The LORD (1:31 So that, just as it is written, “Let him who boasts, boast in the Lord.”)

\$300 Q: In order to become wise, you must first become what?

A: Foolish (3:18 Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you thinks that he is wise in this age, he must become foolish, so that he may become wise.)

\$400 Q: In Chapter 1, Paul exhorts the brethren to what?

A: Agree and be made complete in the same mind (1:10 Now I exhort you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you all agree and that there be no divisions among you, but that you be made complete in the same mind and in the same judgment.)

\$500 Q: How were the apostles treated?

A: Hungry, thirsty, poorly clothed, roughly treated, (4:11 To this present hour we are both hungry and thirsty, and are poorly clothed, and are roughly treated, and are homeless; 12 and we toil, working with our own hands; when we are reviled, we bless; when we are persecuted, we endure; 13 when we are slandered, we try to conciliate; we have become as the scum of the world, the dregs of all things, even until now.)

Category 4 God’s Wisdom:

\$100 Q: For the kingdom of God does not consist in words but in what?

A: Power (4:20 For the kingdom of God does not consist in words but in power.)

\$200 Q: We have the mind of whom?

A: Christ (2:16 For who has known the mind of the Lord, that he will instruct Him? But we have the mind of Christ.)

\$300 Q: Fill in the blank: but we preach Christ crucified, to Jews a _____ and to Gentiles _____.

A: (1:23 But we preach Christ crucified, to Jews a stumbling block* and to Gentiles foolishness*)

\$400 Q: Why has God chosen the foolish things, weak things, base things, and the things that are not?

A: So that no man may boast (1:27-29 27 But God has chosen the foolish things of the world to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to shame the things which are strong, 28 and the base things of the world and the despised God has chosen, the things that are not, so that He may nullify the things that are, 29 so that no man may boast before God.)

\$500 Q: Among the rulers of the earth, God’s wisdom is a what?

A: Mystery (2:6-8 Yet we do speak wisdom among those who are mature; a wisdom, however, not of this age nor of the rulers of this age, who are passing away; 7 but we speak God’s wisdom in a mystery, the hidden wisdom which God predestined before the ages to our glory; 8 the wisdom which none of the rulers of this age has understood; for if they had understood it they would not have crucified the Lord of glory)

Category 5 Areas of Error:

\$100 Q: The foolishness of God is wiser than whom?

A: Men (1:25 Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.)

\$200 Q: The Jews were looking for what? And the gentiles were searching for what?

A: Jews: Signs Gentiles: Wisdom (1:22 For indeed Jews ask for signs and Greeks search for wisdom)

\$300 Q: What were the quarrels in chapter one about?

A: Whom the believers were following (1:12 Now I mean this, that each one of you is saying, “I am of Paul,” and “I of Apollos,” and “I of Cephas,” and “I of Christ.”)

\$400 Q: Because Paul was unable to speak to them as spiritual men, he had to give them what?

A: Milk to drink (3:2 I gave you milk to drink, not solid food; for you were not yet able to receive it. Indeed, even now you are not yet able)

\$500 Q: What did the church at Corinth have among them, where Paul would call them fleshly?

A: Jealously and strife (3:3 For you are still fleshly. For since there is jealousy and strife among you, are you not fleshly, and are you not walking like mere men?)

Category 6 Life of an Apostle:

\$100 Q: What is the foundation that Paul laid at Corinth?

A: Christ (3:11 For no man can lay a foundation other than the one which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.)

\$200 Q: Who examines Paul?

A: The Lord (4:4 For I am conscious of nothing against myself, yet I am not by this acquitted; but the one who examines me is the Lord.)

\$300 Q: A steward must have what attribute about them?

A: Trustworthiness (4:2 In this case, moreover, it is required of stewards that one be found trustworthy.)

\$400 Q: What will test the quality of each man’s work?

A: Fire (3:13-14 Each man’s work will become evident; for the day will show it because it is to be revealed with fire, and the fire itself will test the quality of each man’s work. 14 If any man’s work which he has built on it remains, he will receive a reward.)

\$500 Q: Fill in the blank: For, I think, God has exhibited us apostles last of all, as men condemned to _____; because we have become a spectacle to the world, both to _____ and to _____.

A: (4:9 For, I think, God has exhibited us apostles last of all, as men condemned to death*; because we have become a spectacle to the world, both to angels* and to men*.)
