

# 1 Corinthians Chapters 13-16 Jeopardy Game – Answer Key

## **Category 1 Fill in the blank:**

**\$100 Q: Fill in the blank: Become \_\_\_\_\_ as you ought, and stop \_\_\_\_\_.**

A: Sober-Minded, sinning. (15:34 Become sober-minded\* as you ought, and stop sinning\*; for some have no knowledge of God. I speak this to your shame.)

**\$200 Q: Fill in the Blank: Be on the alert, stand firm in the \_\_\_\_\_, act like \_\_\_\_\_, be \_\_\_\_\_. Let all that you do be done in \_\_\_\_\_.**

A: Faith, Men, Strong, Love. (16:13-14 Be on the alert, stand firm in the faith\*, act like men\*, be strong\*. 14 Let all that you do be done in love\*.)

**\$300 Q: Fill in the blank: For since by a man came \_\_\_\_\_, by a man also came the \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_.**

A: Death, Resurrection of the dead. (15:21 For since by a man came death\*, by a man also came the resurrection\* of the dead\*.)

**\$400 Q: Fill in the blank: When I was a child, I used to \_\_\_\_\_ like a child, \_\_\_\_\_ like a child, \_\_\_\_\_ like a child; when I became a man, I did away with childish things.**

A: Speak, think, reason. (13:11 When I was a child, I used to speak\* like a child, think\* like a child, reason\* like a child; when I became a man, I did away with childish things.)

**\$500 Q: Fill in the blank: If I speak with the tongues of \_\_\_\_\_ and of \_\_\_\_\_, but do not have \_\_\_\_\_, I have become a \_\_\_\_\_ or a \_\_\_\_\_.**

A: Men, angels, love, noisy gong, clanging cymbal. (13:1 If I speak with the tongues of men\* and of angels\*, but do not have love\*, I have become a noisy gong\* or a clanging cymbal\*.)

## **Category 2 Places:**

**\$100 Q: Where was Paul when he wrote 1 Corinthians?**

A: Ephesus. (16:8 But I will remain in Ephesus until Pentecost;)

**\$200 Q: Where was the destination for the gift Paul collected from the Corinthians?**

A: Jerusalem. (16:3 When I arrive, whomever you may approve, I will send them with letters to carry your gift to Jerusalem;)

**\$300 Q: Where is Paul going before he goes to Corinth?**

A: Macedonia. (16:5 But I will come to you after I go through Macedonia, for I am going through Macedonia;)

**\$400 Q: Why did Paul want to stay in Ephesus for a time?**

A: Until Pentecost, for effective service has opened to him. (16:8-9 But I will remain in Ephesus until Pentecost; 9 for a wide door for effective service has opened to me, and there are many adversaries.)

**\$500 Q: What did Paul encourage Apollos to do?**

A: Go to Corinth. (16:12 But concerning Apollos our brother, I encouraged him greatly to come to you with the brethren; and it was not at all his desire to come now, but he will come when he has opportunity.)

# 1 Corinthians Chapters 13-16 Jeopardy Game – Answer Key

## **Category 3 Resurrection:**

**\$100 Q: In the first portion of Chapter 15, what false belief did some of the Corinthians have?**

A: That Christ had not been raised from the dead. (15:12 Now if Christ is preached, that He has been raised from the dead, how do some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?)

**\$200 Q: What would make the Corinthians faith worthless?**

A: If Christ had not been raised from the dead. (15:17 and if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins.)

**\$300 Q: How many people did Christ appear to after His resurrection?**

A: Over 500. (15:6 After that He appeared to more than five hundred brethren at one time, most of whom remain until now, but some have fallen asleep;)

**\$400 Q: Who is the last person Christ revealed Himself to after His resurrection?**

A: Paul. (15:8 and last of all, as to one untimely born, He appeared to me also.)

**\$500 Q: Be precise, what mindset would we have if there were no resurrection?**

A: LET US EAT AND DRINK, FOR TOMORROW WE DIE. (15:32 If from human motives I fought with wild beasts at Ephesus, what does it profit me? If the dead are not raised, let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die.)

## **Category 4 Persons:**

**\$100 Q: Why is Paul the “least of the apostles, and not fit to be called an apostle”?**

A: Because he persecuted the church of God. (15:9 For I am the least of the apostles, and not fit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.)

**\$200 Q: After all things are subject to Christ, then who will Christ be subject to?**

A: God, the Father. (15:28 When all things are subjected to Him, then the Son Himself also will be subjected to the One who subjected all things to Him, so that God may be all in all.)

**\$300 Q: What does Maranatha mean?**

A: Come, O Lord, Come. (16:22 If anyone does not love the Lord, he is to be accursed. Maranatha.)

**\$400 Q: What type of men did Paul tell the Corinthians to be in subjection to?**

A: Men devoted for ministry to the Saints and to everyone who helps in the work and labors. (16:15-16 Now I urge you, brethren (you know the household of Stephanas, that they were the first fruits of Achaia, and that they have devoted themselves for ministry to the saints), 16 that you also be in subjection to such men and to everyone who helps in the work and labors.)

**\$500 Q: The first Adam became what? And the second Adam became what?**

A: Living soul, Life giving spirit. (15:45 So also it is written, “The first man, Adam, became a living soul.” The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.)

### **Category 5 Christian Living:**

**\$100 Q: What gift does Paul say they should especially pursue?**

A: Prophecy. (14:1 Pursue love, yet desire earnestly spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.)

**\$200 Q: What did they stand upon; what are they saved by; and what did they hold fast to?**

A: Gospel. (15:1-2 Now I make known to you, brethren, the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received, in which also you stand, 2 by which also you are saved, if you hold fast the word which I preached to you, unless you believed in vain.)

**\$300 Q: What kind of manner are all things to be done in the church?**

A: Orderly. (14:40 But all things must be done properly and in an orderly manner.)

**\$400 Q: In the church all things are done for what?**

A: Edification. (14:26 What is the outcome then, brethren? When you assemble, each one has a psalm, has a teaching, has a revelation, has a tongue, has an interpretation. Let all things be done for edification.)

**\$500 Q: Flesh and blood cannot what?**

A: Inherit the kingdom of God. (15:50 Now I say this, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable.)

A: Tongues edify the individual, Prophecy edifies the Church. 14:4

**Q: Paul compares tongues to what instruments?**

A: Flute and Harp. 14:7

**Q: In regard to what should we be infants?**

A: Evil. 14:20

**Q: As the Corinthians prospered, when did Paul tell them to put aside and save.**

A: On the first day of every week. 16:2

**Q: What is the power of sin?**

A: The law. 15:56

**Q: Love does not rejoice in what?**

A: Unrighteousness 13:6
